Wireless Internet

There are two easy ways to get online wirelessly while you are on the UConn campus:

Eduroam: If your home institution participates in eduroam, your laptop (etc.) is likely set up to connect to the eduroam wireless network automatically; if it does not connect, and you need help signing in, check this website for instructions: <https://network.uconn.edu/eduroam/>

We are aware of the near pragmatic incoherence of the advice to check a website when you can’t get online. . . If no one can briefly lend you their internet access, please just ask one of the organizers or conference helpers. Or go online non-securely using the option below to check the eduroam website.

UConn-GUEST network: A non-encrypted, non-secure wireless service that guests to UConn may use to access the internet. Just connect to the network, agree to the Individual Responsibilities with Respect to Appropriate Use of IT Resources, and you’re online.

Lunches, Coffee, Refreshments

Quiet Room
